## Certificate III in Hospitality (Food and Beverage)

The Certificate III in Hospitality (Food and Beverage) is designed to identify your skills and knowledge as a food and beverage attendant or catering assistant in the hospitality industry.

Work such as preparing and serving drinks and cocktails, operating a bar and performing table service can have been undertaken in various hospitality settings such as restaurants, hotels, motels, catering operations, clubs, pubs, cafes and coffee shops.

Individuals may have had some responsibility for others and have worked in a team environment.

## Certificate III in Hospitality (Commercial Cookery)

The Certificate III in Hospitality (Commercial Cookery) is designed to identify your skills and knowledge in food preparation and food service industries, as a qualified cook.

Work can have been undertaken in various hospitality enterprises where food is prepared and served, including restaurants, hotels, clubs, pubs, cafes, cafeterias and coffee shops. Individuals may have had some responsibility for others and provided technical advice and support to a team.

Successful completion of competencies within this course will accredit towards the Diploma of Hospitality Management.

#### Recognition of Prior Learning:

If you have lived it or learned it, you may have already earned it! We recognise your skills and knowledge that you may have obtained from work experience (paid or unpaid), previous training, community and volunteer work and other skills obtained through life experience. Fees associated with RPL enrolments are generally less than completing a course via other means and will vary depending on units of competencies, fee structure and assessment pathway required.
