### The Challenge

#### School Selection

- All schools in the Sunshine Coast district will be invited to participate
- Schools are encouraged to enter their most competent teams. A team will consist of two students who are enrolled in Grades 10, 11 or 12 on 3 September 2011
- The capacity of the Sunshine Coast TAFE kitchen limits the number of teams to 18
- Schools will be limited to one team per school in the first instance, however they may nominate more than one team. Nominations must be ranked in order of preference ie A team, 1st reserve, 2nd reserve etc

#### Allocation of Places

- In the first instance if more than 18 schools nominate, places will be allocated to A Teams on a 'first in best dressed basis'
- If less than 18 schools nominate, all A teams will be accepted then the balance of places will be allocated by way of random draw (ie drawn out of a hat) with all teams other than the already accepted A teams having the chance to participate

# Format of the Challenge - Saturday 3 September 2011

## 9.00 am

- Arrive at the Sunshine Coast TAFE Mooloolaba Campus - 34 Lady Musgrave Drive, Mountain Creek
- Rotarians will be present to direct you to the unloading bay behind the kitchen. Once goods are unloaded students should then assemble in the Bistro area

## 9.00 am – 10.00 am

- Store goods in kitchen
- Set up table
- Dress in uniform
- Provide costings - receipts for material purchases will be required to substantiate costs
- Details of costs, in report form, are to be placed on table together with menu and laminated sheet detailing school name and names of team members

## 10.00 am – 11.00 am

- Safety induction and workplace familiarisation
- Any team that is not present at this induction will not be permitted to participate
- Allocation of teams to kitchens

## Important Information for Students

Students should note that the cost of ingredients to prepare a three course meal for two people must not exceed \$40.00

### Students are to bring the following equipment:

- Knives
- Small utensils such as pastry brushes, moulds and peelers
- Two (2) laminated A4 size posters depicting their school's name and their names. One will be used at their workspace and the other should be displayed on their table
- Students are to wear name badges as part of their work uniform
- Sunshine Coast TAFE will provide saucepans, frying pans, etc

### As presentation is an integral part of the judging criteria, students should also bring:

- Table settings eg table cloths, serviettes, serving dishes, plates and cutlery. Although Sunshine Coast TAFE has offered the use of their equipment, in this regard it is felt that students would be better served by bringing their own

### Workplace health and safety necessitates participants to wear the following:

- Long trousers, shirt, hat or hair net and an apron/chef's jacket
- Enclosed shoes must be worn (the wearing of socks is also compulsory)
- Members of each team are to wear a matching uniform so that they can be clearly identifiable as a team
- Students should bring their lunch as the Sunshine Coast TAFE Cafeteria will not be open
